

Utah Congressional District 4

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A Demographic Profile

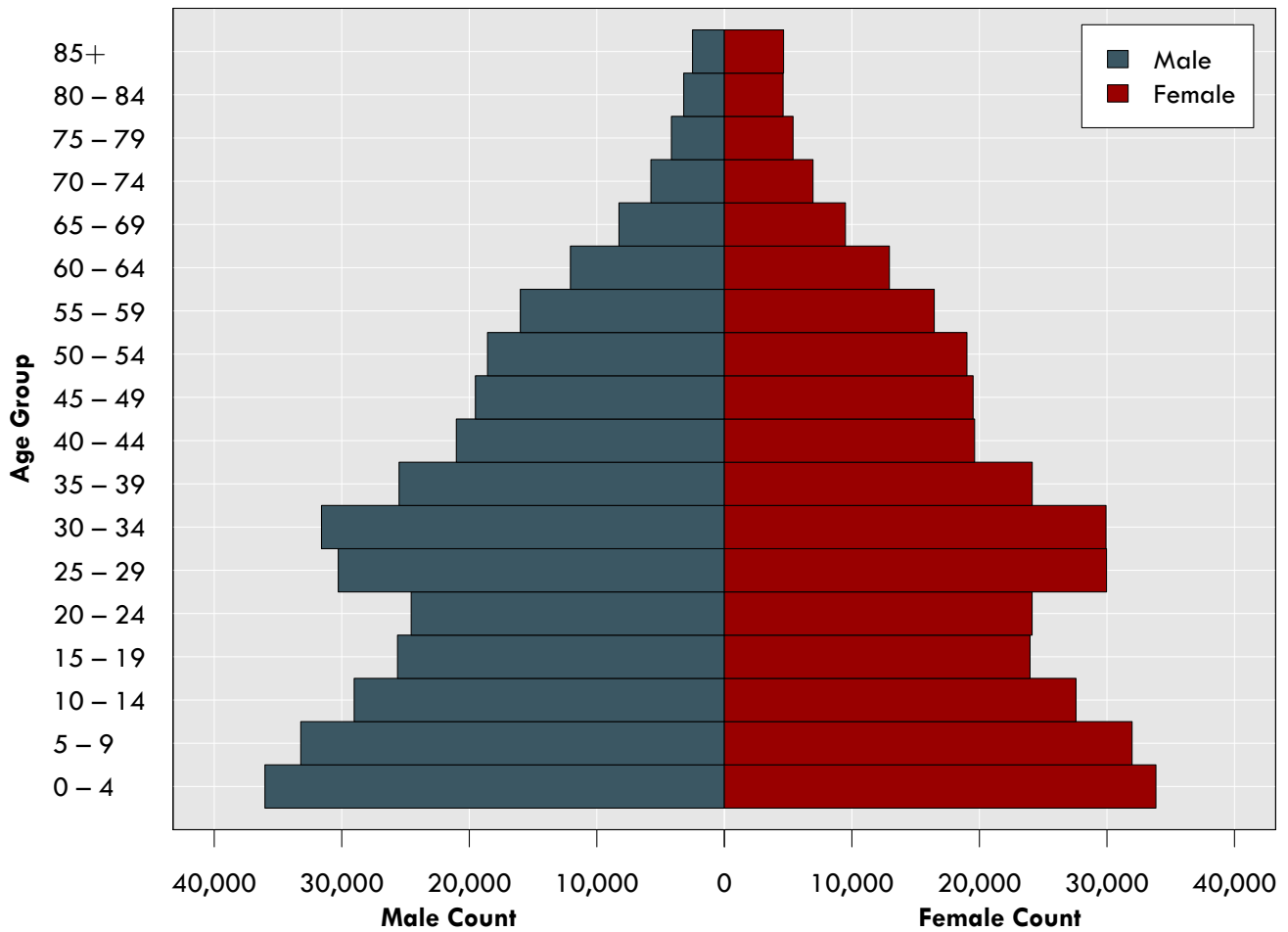


Figure 2: Congressional District 4 Population Composition by Race

Table 1 and Figure 1 show the composition of Congressional District 4 population among age and gender groups. Table 2 and Figure 2 show the composition of population among racial groups. These demographic statistics are based on the 2010 Census and 2013 Congressional Districts. The corresponding statistics for the State of Utah are shown for comparison. The total district population was 690,971 persons, with a median age of 29.6 overall, 30.1 for females and 29.1 for males (statewide, median ages are 29.2 overall, 29.7 for females, and 28.7 for males).

Figure 1: Congressional District 4 Population Pyramid
