

Utah State House District 35

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A Demographic Profile

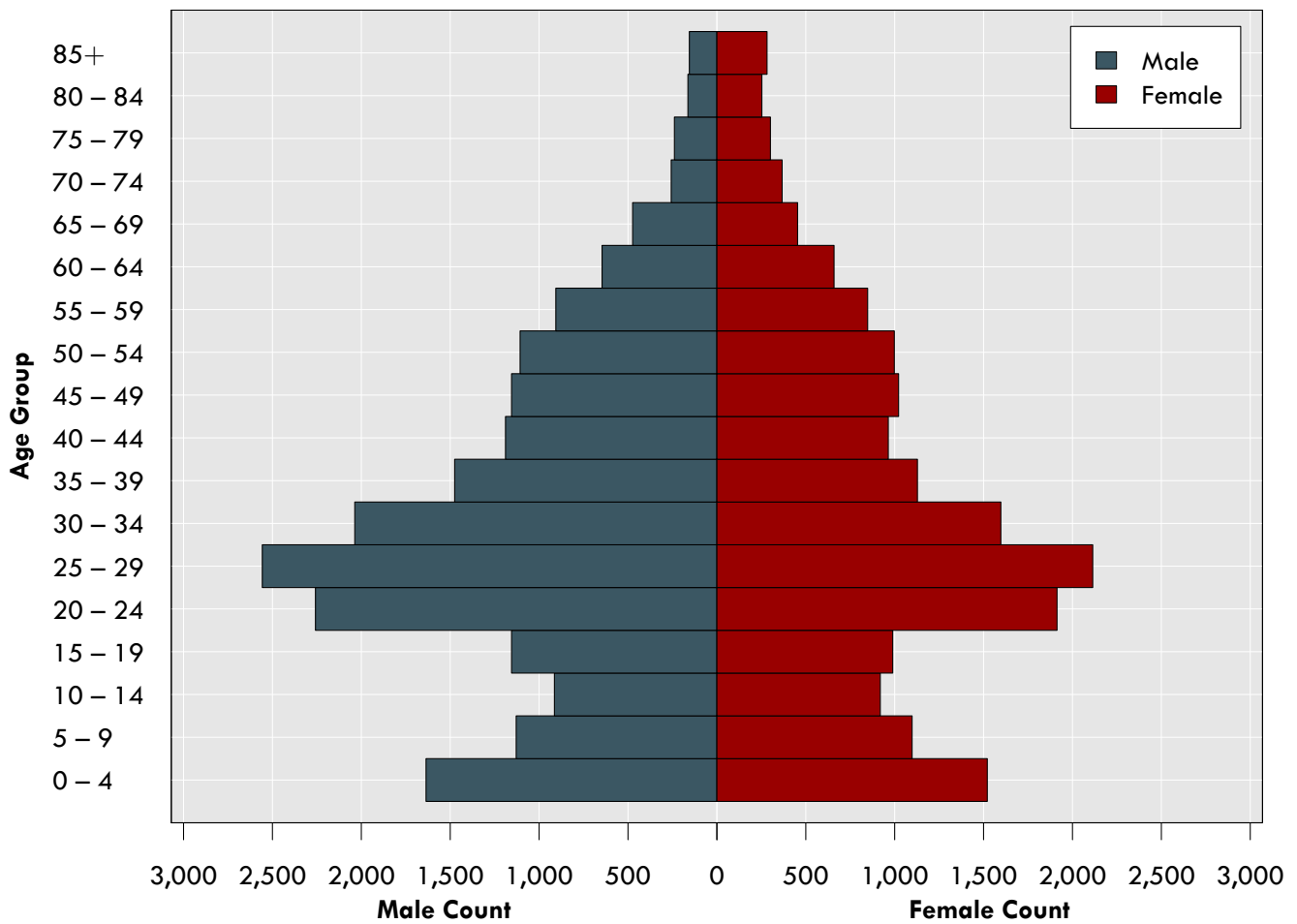


Figure 2: House District 35 Population Composition by Race

Table 1 and Figure 1 show the composition of House District 35 population among age and gender groups. Table 2 and Figure 2 show the composition of population among racial groups. These demographic statistics are based on the 2010 Census and 2013 House Districts. The corresponding statistics for the State of Utah are shown for comparison. The total district population was 36,879 persons, with a median age of 30.3 overall, 30.5 for females and 30.2 for males (statewide, median ages are 29.2 overall, 29.7 for females, and 28.7 for males).

Figure 1: House District 35 Population Pyramid
