A Demographic Profile

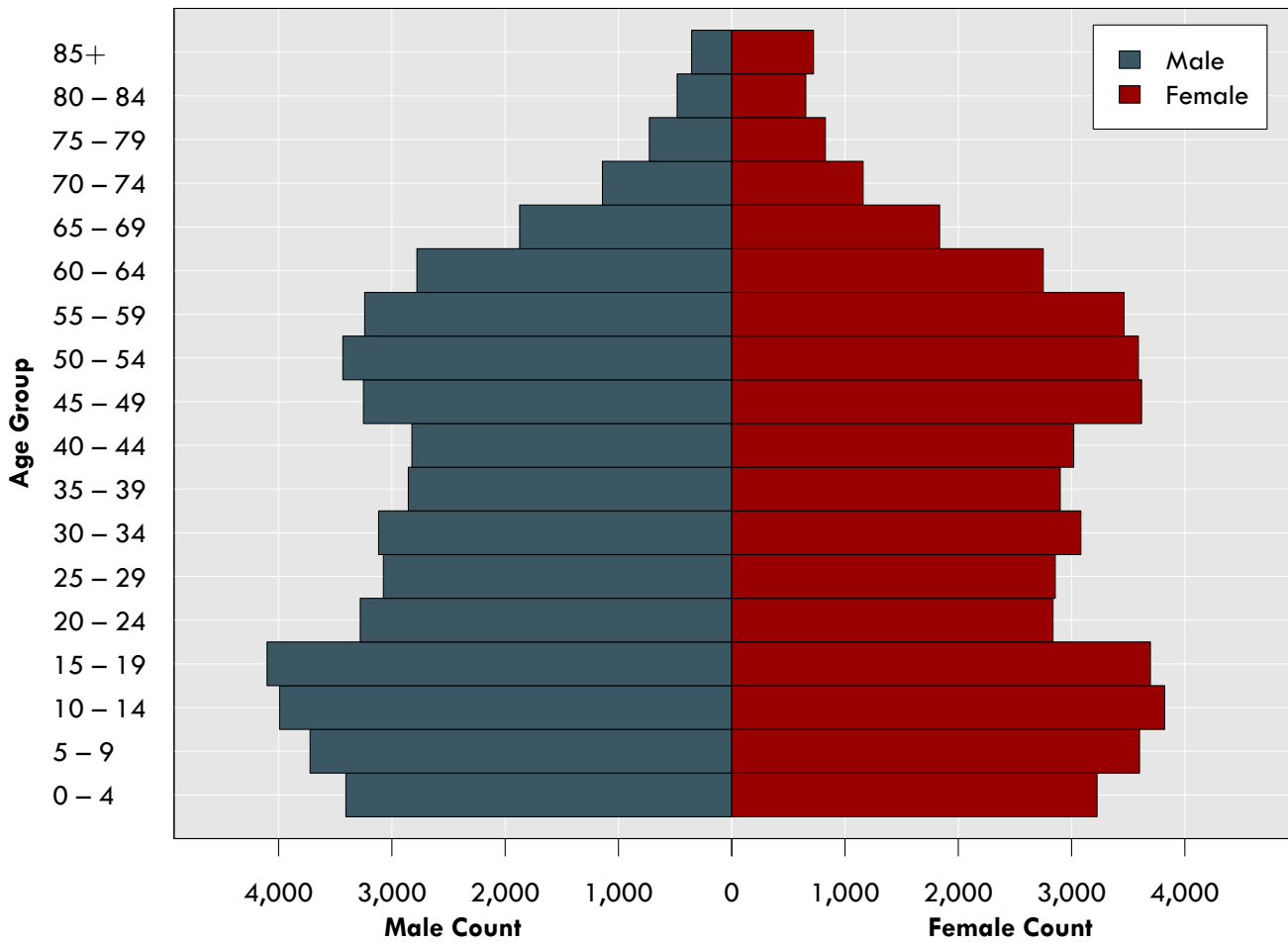


Figure 2: Senate District 9 Population Composition by Race

Table 1 and Figure 1 show the composition of Senate District 9 population among age and gender groups. Table 2 and Figure 2 show the composition of population among racial groups. These demographic statistics are based on the 2010 Census and 2013 Senate Districts. The corresponding statistics for the State of Utah are shown for comparison. The total district population was 95,306 persons, with a median age of 34.9 overall, 36.2 for females and 33.6 for males (statewide, median ages are 29.2 overall, 29.7 for females, and 28.7 for males).

Figure 1: Senate District 9 Population Pyramid
